

The photo is taken in 1995, on the roof of my house, on the 16-th store the idea was "maintain balance". I was standing on a narrow rail, I can show the place if you like.

Well, I was standing here and nobody held me. Guram
Tsibakhashvilli didn't want to shoot me: what am I to tell your mother, if you fall down? I had no husband then. At last his professionalism prevailed and he told me then I'll shoot you to the last. Well, here is an installation as you see, New York is behind me..

### Zuleika Bajbeuk-Melikova Pointelism or Zuleikizm?

It is not pointelism at all, no points, I work with a brush. I do not spare colours. I put colour on colour, than there are much colours and when I run over with the brush I want to create impression of light vibration, shades. That is why there is the effect of points...

They say it is impressionistic style. I work according to my heart. I hate "zims". They are invented by art critics. This is not right. Should there necessarily be a stamp? This is "Zuleikizm" as one person called it. Il liked it. Zuleiki at means me. I work very hard and the more I work the works become more mine. I put energetics (a fashionable word, but I can' think of another word) in a concrete canvas. The more I work the more odd it becomes for others. I get in my world, and my world becomes difficult to understand, incomprehensible for the spectators. It does not mean that they are good or had, it is my individual world... and the more I put in the work it becomes more mine.

Action "No 999" Description in Words

A 5.30 the anist together with a director, a cameramen, two curators and several people holding the same views went to Didube by two cars. (Tseretell avenue, the first election sign-board). Before the arist's arrival, the cameraman got to work and with great "enthusiasm" started asking passers-by about "Koko Varrardaze" - a deputy. Among the cilizens there was one who knew him and it was possible to vote for him. (It is shot on the video). Witnessing this fact, the arist began to stick the posters on the false-election sign-boards and walls.( the posters say: - vote for me", Koko Varardaz No 1991.

The action was accompanied by us - viewer-witnesses. We were interested in what was happening beyond the demonstration area "beyond broders". Participation of passers-by with they comments and arrogant denial. The "playing ground" was gradually expanding. The action was minimal, but the presence of camera and the director's instructions required the artists movements to be repeated several times. It was very rhythmical itself and created "obscure" absurd sentiments. At 7.10 the action finished on Didube exhibition territory.

I am still subject to dualism. In Tbilisi I am considered Russian, in Russia I am considered Georgian. My first language is Russian. But when I am in Russia they tell me I have Georgian pronunciation. It is a great advantage for me. Generally the synthesis is good for people who are related to the Art. You can think on a large scale, and not be fastened to small things, let's say ethnic, ethnography or national roots it is very good, fantastic and necessary in itself but it gives me amplitude of thinking, I have a great choice. This synthesis is very interesting. I think Georgia is such a place, it is a frontier between west and east, where everything is bound to each other like colors on a carpet, and the cultures are mixed. I think it is an excellent place for an artist.



### Iliko Zautashvili 100% Silk

The name of this work is Sweet Life. Of course it could be decided in different ways, but I've chosen I'zl klichen knives, which were taken from theircontext. kitchen context and put into space and art context. This sweetness has its other side, just the thing, our present life brings about, what the contemporary men is striving for. There is less danger that the picture can vanish. 

#### Twenty five years of solitude

At first only plasticine animals lived in this town. Than they became human. That means they had wings, tails and over time they lost them. In childhood! performed plastic operations. Ears and wings disturbed them. I have been making this town from 6 years. In childhood I played with it all the time and never showed it to one person and he liked it, then other one liked it. Then Guram Tsibakhashvili saw it and advised me to make an exhibition. We thought out how to exhibit!, It made photos. There were photos along with texts and the plasticine figures.

## **Murtaz Shvelidze Murtaz TV**

It was an old workshop of broken Tv-s. I had a job there a year ago and sometimes I had a free time. These old TVs were in such a poor condition that I got an idea to paint football. But it was paradoxical that I painted a shot from a film first and made this work afterwards.



### **Koka Ramishvili Ready Made**

This idea was initiated 6 years ago and was connected with the changes that took place in the post soviet period. What was happening in Tbilisi in 93-94 it was the stream from the west quite aggressive and also the aggressive echo from the east. I wanted to take deep national layer, fundamental layer, we may say so, such as church embroidery. It is a kind of metaphor of eastern echo of 94, and on the other hand the words which were very popular among mass media: sex, criminal, corruption, ego, morfium, heroin and etc. It is a handmade thing, quite complex, it was made by Dodo Baramidze, who actually paints icons, and as to me I've made design and watercolours. When I proposed this work to Mrs. Dodo Baramidze, she had such a reaction fundamental embroidery and words like corruption, criminal. She was thinking for a while and finally there was an answer from her that it is like Bosch's works. There is a camouflage camouflage of beauty- very beautiful from outside and the content absolutely opposite. I wanted to connect these two paradoxical systems in this work.

I live here and I am not alone. We all love each other. I live in all puppets, but most of all in this one. I don't know whether the puppet resembles me or vice versa. Over time we change similarly. Unkind puppets do not exist. We all know that. Separation is hard.



Video aesthetics, screen technology has a great role in modern world. It is one of the main trends in modern visual arts that is not neutral by nature and, to say not straightforwardly, becomes a real source of influence on socio-cultural processes and multic relations.

The group of art critics and curators (A.Gabunia, N.Gujabidze) has been working in this direction from 1999. For this purpose they involved professional film director (K.Gujabidze) and cameramen (D.Gujabidze, G.Beridze) in the work in order to establish a precedent of recording development of modern Georgian art of recent decade in documentary and feature films. How was proceeding reconsideration and reinterpretation of artistic languages, situations, work processes, concepts, versatility of visual art. Within the bounds of this genre selfidentification of artists appeared to be on the border of documentary and video esthetics, where documentary film language, images, plots and types were gradually oppressed by experimental video interpretation and within the broad of new general.

The material collected during six years is a very interesting videolaboratory, where aritists of different generations and conceptual trends are assembled together. Such video structure does not include consistent line and has even the function of archival, educational filter. Nowadays when changes of paradigms are more frequent than biological change of generations we get phenomenon of "coexistence" of different cultural epochs. Therefore cultural texture becomes very sensitive and easy disintegrated to autonomous groups, which have their own assessment parameters, communication language, and their system of symbols. Therefore video films occur to be independent observer, which create communication video communication space comprehensible and acceptable for all.

Except of mentioned video almanacs five video arts are included in the video programme which are initiated by the group of curators and which are placed in the concept net of common liberal freedoms. Video actionist screen pictures contact with the society via
